Petition requirements for 2018 Primary Election

Major Party Candidates can be nominated by assembly or they may petition onto the Primary Election ballot. A major party candidate may not petition onto the ballot if they have attempted and failed to receive at least 10 percent of the votes at their party's assembly.

Minor Party Candidates nominated by assembly are placed on the General Election ballot unless there is more than one candidate for that office nominated by assembly and/or petition; then the candidates are placed on the Primary Election ballot.

Petition requirements for 2018 General Election

Minor Party Candidates nominated by assembly are placed on the General Election ballot unless there is more than one candidate for that office nominated by assembly and/or petition; then the candidates are placed on the Primary Election ballot.

Unaffiliated Candidates are nominated by petition and are placed directly on the General Election ballot. There is no Primary Election for unaffiliated candidates.
